Campers are divided into age groups and supervised by a qualified childcare provider and an assistant. Every day, campers will engage in morning and afternoon activities such as French, Science, Art, Music, Technology, and Gym, with field trips or a special guest visit scheduled on Fridays. We offer Junior Discovery Camp for ages 2.5 to 3, and Senior Discovery Camp for ages 4 to 6.

FRENCH

Campers will be exposed to the integrated AIM French Teaching Method, which teaches the French language via action-based activities in theatre, dance, and music.

TECHNOLOGY

Campers have the opportunity to enjoy learning via the use of technology. Various engaging, interactive, and instructive software/apps stimulate campers' imaginations while assisting in developing their technical abilities.

ART

Campers express and develop their creativity in the Arts by working with various media such as painting, sculpting, drawing, and collage.

SCIENCE

Campers will also learn about various themes in the Life, Physical, and Natural Sciences. Hands-on activities will help students learn process skills such as observing, describing, discussing, comparing, and predicting.

MUSIC
